



Total Bartlesville Investment

The Bartlesville Community Foundation is a collection of endowed funds that benefit the charitable organizations, programs, and special projects of Bartlesville. The purpose of the Foundation is to provide a steady source of income to these entities, as well as special grants, following the wishes of the donors that contribute to and create the funds.

By bringing funds together, the Foundation is able to provide administrative, investment, and grant making support for everyone, eliminating the need for individual donors to set up separate institutions, formulate policies, file innumerable forms, and monitor the status of grant recipients. As a public charity, The Bartlesville Community Foundation allows for the greatest tax deductions permitted by law and your tax status.



Programs That Make a Difference



The Bartlesville Community Foundation seeks to encourage charitable giving that lasts a lifetime. To help encourage younger donors, we launched the Flash Philanthropy program. Flash Philanthropy allows those ages 21-40 to pledge \$500 or more individually or in groups so they can pool their gifts and grant it out to a community nonprofit. Last year, nine groups provided \$5,000, and the Foundation solicited and processed grants from the Bartlesville nonprofit sector. The group then reviewed those grants and awarded the money. This year, Flash Philanthropy will provide over \$6,000 to area charities. The Foundation hopes these young donors will help lead the next generation of Bartlesville charitable giving. Paths to Independence is an accredited PK-12 private school that meets the needs of students with autism spectrum disorders.
