2021 Scholarship deadline for submission is Friday, March 12, 2021, by 5pm.

To apply for a scholarship with the Bartlesville Community Foundation, please:

- Complete the BCF Scholarship Application Form accompanying each scholarship
- Provide any scholarship-specific addendums to the application form
- Include a copy of your submitted FAFSA application
 - FAFSA means **full FAFSA** with **all** pages. This is not just the cover letter stating whether or not you are eligible for financial aid but the full 10 page report.
- Submit current transcript **with** ACT scores
 - If your transcript does not include your most recent ACT scores, please attach them separately
- Please follow submission guidelines:
 - No staples
 - Printed single sided if possible
 - Do not fold application documents
 - Please submit individual applications and scholarship-specific addendums attached in separate envelopes or folders, paperclipped or binder clipped
 - For example, if applying for multiple scholarships, put each scholarship and specific addendums in the same envelope/folder and the second in another envelope/folder.
 - Do not provide attachments that are not requested by the scholarship
 - For example, if applying for a scholarship that DOES NOT request a resume DO NOT include a resume. It will not be reviewed.

Where applicable, “service to school” is defined as involvement in school activities, such as clubs, service organizations, school government, pep squad, athletics, etc.

Scholarship recipients will be required to complete and return a scholarship acceptance form providing necessary information about their school of choice prior to grants being paid.

Award recipients will either be recognized at their high school awards assembly or be notified directly by Bartlesville Community Foundation no later than May 31st of that application year.

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DD Boesiger Memorial Fund STEM & Aviation Scholarship

The family and friends of Dwight D. Boesiger created this scholarship in memory of Dwight in 2018. Dwight worked over 30 years as a Chemical Engineer with Phillips Petroleum Company primarily in Research and Development. Upon retirement in 1993, Dwight pursued his passion for flying and became a certified flight instructor. Teaching others to fly was one of his biggest thrills and nothing made him happier than seeing his students become proficient pilots.

Dwight was also a continuous student and delved with glee into researching any project he undertook. He enjoyed tutoring and encouraging students in the pursuit of science and technology.

In memory of Dwight's penchant for research, and drive to share knowledge and encourage learning, this award is presented each year to a college-bound senior who is interested in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM), or Aviation; and who embodies the qualities of a natural leader –integrity, community involvement, and a positive attitude.

Award:

Scholarship awarded to a student intending to pursue a career in STEM or Aviation-related studies.

Entries will be evaluated by a review committee. Recipient will be selected based on adherence to prescribed criteria, strength of essay, financial need, and strong character as demonstrated through letters of recommendation.

Amount Available: Up to \$2,000 payable as 50 percent per semester for the first year as long as a 3.0 or higher college grade point average is maintained. Recipients may be invited to reapply for scholarship dollars for a second year. Students are eligible to receive up to a maximum of \$4,000 in scholarship money payable to the university, college, junior college, trade or vocational school on behalf of the recipient, following proof of acceptance and adherence to the below eligibility criteria. Student's may also receive a \$1,000 grant upon earning a Private Pilot's Certificate, or instrument rating. Additional documentation may be required in order to receive this grant.

Eligibility Criteria:

- High School or Tri-County Tech student in good standing and qualifying for graduation.
- Unless a college student invited to reapply, the applicant must be a resident of one of the following Oklahoma counties: Washington or Osage. Or the following Kansas counties: Montgomery and Chautauqua
- 3.0 or higher GPA for high school and college students



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Eligibility Criteria Continued:

- Student intends to pursue a degree in STEM or Aviation-related field and/or become a private pilot.
- Strong consideration given to students who reflect significant financial need
- Consideration given to students active in extra-curricular activities that focus on mentoring youth

Application:

- Complete general Bartlesville Community Foundation scholarship application
- 2 letters of recommendation – *see below*
- Typed personal essay addressing the topic “Why I want to pursue a STEM/Aviation-related field of study.” Essay must be between 500-1000 words.
- A brief personal biography 200-500 words

Letters of Recommendation:

Please submit two letters of recommendation with your application. Letters must be submitted in a sealed envelope and the seal signed by the author of the letter. Each letter must be submitted by the student with the scholarship application before the scholarship deadline.

- One letter must be from a faculty member of the applicant’s school
- The second letter can be from any unrelated community member, teacher, mentor, etc. of the student’s choice
