Scholarship deadline for submission is Friday, March 12, 2021, by 5pm.

To apply for a scholarship with the Bartlesville Community Foundation, please:

- Complete the BCF Scholarship Application Form accompanying each scholarship
- Provide any scholarship-specific addendums to the application form
- Include a copy of your submitted FAFSA application
 - FAFSA means **full FAFSA** with **all** pages. This is not just the cover letter stating whether or not you are eligible for financial aid but the full 10 page report.
- Submit current transcript **with** ACT scores
 - If your transcript does not include your most recent ACT scores, please attach them separately
- Please follow submission guidelines:
 - No staples
 - Printed single sided if possible
 - Do not fold application documents
 - Please submit individual applications and scholarship-specific addendums attached in separate envelopes or folders, paperclipped or binder clipped
 - For example, if applying for multiple scholarships, put each scholarship and specific addendums in the same envelope/folder and the second in another envelope/folder.
 - Do not provide attachments that are not requested by the scholarship
 - For example, if applying for a scholarship that DOES NOT request a resume DO NOT include a resume. It will not be reviewed.

Where applicable, “service to school” is defined as involvement in school activities, such as clubs, service organizations, school government, pep squad, athletics, etc.

Scholarship recipients will be required to complete and return a scholarship acceptance form providing necessary information about their school of choice prior to grants being paid.

Award recipients will either be recognized at their high school awards assembly or be notified directly by Bartlesville Community Foundation no later than May 31st of that application year.

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Glenn and Anne Dodwell Memorial Scholarship

Dr. Glenn W. Dodwell was born in New York City, New York, spent his younger years in Teaneck, New Jersey and then in Glen Rock, New Jersey where he graduated from high school. He received his PhD in Chemistry from Worcester Polytechnic Institute at Worcester, Massachusetts. He then pursued a career in the chemical engineering profession. Dr. Dodwell holds multiple patents for his work in chemical research. He came to Bartlesville in 1998 and was employed as a research chemist with Phillips Petroleum company until his retirement.

Anne M. Dodwell was born in Millinocket, Maine. She spent her younger years in Maine before attending Becker College in Worcester, Massachusetts where she received a nursing diploma and then Maryville College in St. Louis, Missouri where she received a Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Anne then attended Columbia University in New York City where she received a Master of Science in Nursing with specialization in Anesthesia. She was employed at Columbia Hospital in New York City and then came to Bartlesville in 1998 and accepted employment at Jane Phillips Medical Center as a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist.

Glenn and Anne married in 1975 in Worcester, Massachusetts. Anne enjoyed exercising, Zumba, lounging by the pool and spending time with her godchildren. She passed away in 2013. Dr. Dodwell enjoyed spending time with close friends and his godchildren. Dr. Dodwell passed away in 2018.

Together through this scholarship, Glenn and Anne Dodwell's legacy will live on as they help others pursue careers in the areas of study they found so meaningful.

Award: Scholarships will be awarded to students pursuing chemistry, chemical engineering undergraduate, graduate or PHD studies. Registered Nurses pursuing advanced education to become a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist may also be eligible to apply. Although we encourage anyone who is eligible to apply, **priority will be given to students beginning a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist program.**

Students must be a graduate of a high school within the Bartlesville or Dewey school district boundaries.

Entries will be evaluated by a review committee. Recipient will be selected based on adherence to prescribed criteria, strength of essays, financial need, and strong character as demonstrated through the letters of recommendation.



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Amount Available: Up to \$10,000 per year of study payable as 50 percent per semester to the college or university of the student's choosing as long as the GPA requirements (3.0 or higher) is achieved. Students may be eligible to reapply and have their applications reviewed by the scholarship committee every year until successful graduation with a degree in chemistry, chemical engineering or have become a Certified Nurse Anesthetist.

Multiple \$10,000 scholarships may be awarded.

Proof of acceptance to the college/university of the students choice and adherence to the below eligibility criteria is required.

Eligibility Criteria: High School Applicants

- High School student in good standing and qualifying for graduation at a high school from within the Bartlesville or Dewey school district boundaries
- 3.5 or higher GPA or higher
- Majoring in chemistry or chemical engineering or is a Registered Nurse pursuing education to become a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist.
- A complete BCF scholarship application
- *To receive funding for the second semester, evidence that the student is on a path to achieving a degree in chemistry or chemical engineering will be required*
 - Transcript with degree determination
 - Plan of study from college counselor
 - Other
- Answer the two following essay questions in 300-500 words each
 - What makes you excited about this field of study?
 - How do you see this field of study evolving and how do you hope to impact this change?
- Two letters of recommendation
 - First should be from a high school counselor or teacher
 - Second should be from another unrelated party (teacher, community member, coach, mentor, etc.)

Eligibility Criteria: Post-Secondary/Non-Traditional Student Applicants

- Most recent copy of a college transcript
 - Transcript must show undergraduate degree completion if you are applying for a masters, PhD, or Certified Nurse Anesthetist scholarship
- College GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Two letters of recommendation
 - First should be from an employer, professor/teacher, or academic advisor



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- Second should be from another unrelated party (employer, teacher, community member, coach, mentor, etc.)

- BCF General Scholarship application
- Answer the two following essay questions in 300-500 words each
 - What makes you excited about this field of study?
 - How do you see this field of study evolving and how do you hope to impact this change?
- Evidence of pursuit of chemistry, chemical engineering or Certified Nurse Anesthetist degree path
 - Transcript with degree determination
 - Plan of study from college counselor
 - Other

Letters of Recommendation:

Please submit letters of recommendation with your completed application. Letters must be submitted in a sealed envelope and the seal signed by the author of the letter. Each letter must be submitted by the student with the scholarship before the scholarship deadline.
